St Vincent de Paul Society Northern Territory is a community-based charity supporting people experiencing poverty, homelessness and social disadvantage across the Northern Territory.

Through volunteers, retail shops, and outreach services, the organisation provides emergency relief.

As the organisation continued to grow across multiple sites, maintaining effective workplace health and safety systems became increasingly important.



The Challenge

Reliance on paper based systems

A lack of digital tools was causing an administrative burden.

Limited visibility across sites

Multi sites without one central system lead to communication issues.

Inefficient incident reporting

No system to report incidents easily led to a lack of action.

Increasing audit demands

A lack of structured system was not enough to stay compliant for funding.
