# Transforming the Safety System of Yumbah Aquaculture.

Yumbah Aquaculture is a leading Australian seafood producer, operating across 17 sites in Victoria, New South Wales, Tasmania, and South Australia. The company farms mussels, oysters, abalone, and kingfish using sustainable systems that replicate natural processes, while reducing pressure on wild catch and upholding high standards of quality and environmental stewardship. Yumbah Aquaculture is still in the implementation process with the Safety Champion and continues to make improvements.

#### Reactive approach

A largely reactive approach led to oversight and a lack of consistency.

#### Risk management

The safety system lacked structure and visibility across multiple sites.

#### Compliance complexity

Food safety and quality requirements, operating across four different state safety jurisdictions.
